Guided Sturgeon Tour A Success!



Over 25 participants joined Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council and Sturgeon for Tomorrow on May 6 for a guided tour along the Upper Black River to view the rare and threatened sturgeon. While onlookers eagerly snapped pictures, two sturgeon were pulled from the water for marking by the research students from MSU. The sturgeon in this photo was a 90-pound male while the other fish pulled was a female, weighing about 40 pounds.
