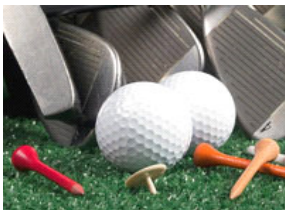
**Research, Habitat, & Conservation are Imperative**

The conservation of these important fish will require an integrated and collaborative research approach through field and laboratory studies. Rehabilitation and recovery programs will provide high quality and innovative research on sturgeon biology, habitat conservation, management, and hatchery technology for enhancement and restoration. This research will aid in conserving and restoring the sturgeon populations throughout the Cheboygan River Watershed.

**Streamside Rearing/Hatchery Needs**

There is revolutionary potential for development of stream-side aquaculture production. Sturgeon For Tomorrow, the Michigan DNR, the Tower-Kleber Limited Partnership and Michigan State University researchers have opened a streamside rearing facility/sturgeon hatchery near the Kleber Dam. This partnership will collaborate in rearing lake sturgeon and conducting culture

research on native sturgeon species in the areas of husbandry, nutrition, health, reproduction and genetics.

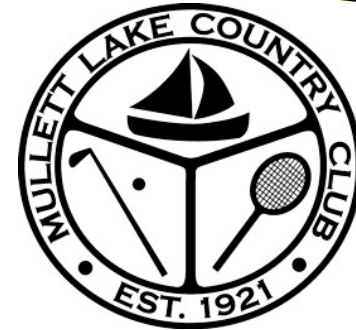
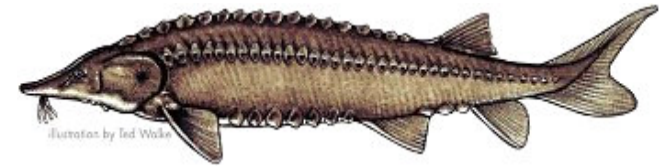

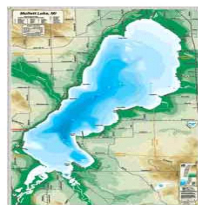
Mullett Lake Country Club is a GAM rated, 9-hole regulation length golf course. This short layout will reward good shots and provide a fun golf outing for everyone.

The Mullett Lake Country Club is on Mullett Lake off of M-27 about 6 miles south of Cheboygan.

The lake is approximately 10 miles long from southeast to north-east, about 4 miles at its widest, and 120 feet at its deepest. It covers 17,360 acres, making it the third largest inland lake in Michigan.

Mullett lake is an excellent fishery, containing large populations of many game species, and most notably the lake sturgeon.

The Michigan state record lake sturgeon was harvested from Mullett Lake in 1974. This fish was 7'3" long and weighed 193 pounds and was harvested by Joe Maka.

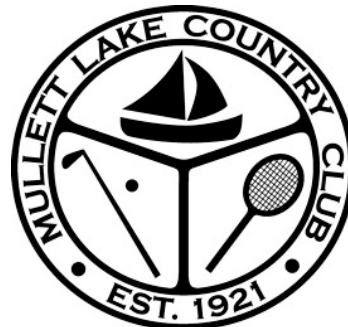
