Fisheries, Wildlife or Natural Resources Conservation Scholarship

Scholarship Information

The award is in the amount of One Thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each.

Deadline for submission is March 15.

Scholarship recipients must be a High School graduate at Cheboygan Area High School, Inland Lakes High School, or Onaway High School with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

Scholarships will be awarded to deserving students to cover direct expenses related to their tuition, fees, books, room and board, and other costs related to their studies.

The Sturgeon For Tomorrow (SFT) Fisheries, Wildlife or Natural Resources Scholarship

was established to promote the mission of Sturgeon For Tomorrow, "to assist fisheries managers in the rehabilitation of lake sturgeon". Scholarships were designed to provide tangible encouragement and public recognition for academic achievement or community service to a student with a course of study in the field of Fisheries, Wildlife or Natural Resources conservation. The goal of these scholarships are to further the objectives of SFT by rewarding and promoting the education and development of future fisheries professionals.

The criteria to be used in the selection of the recipient of these awards are:

- High School graduate at Cheboygan Area High School, Inland Lakes High School, or Onaway High School
- Enrollment in a course of study in the area of fisheries, wildlife, or natural resource conservation, or other related field
- Grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

Applicants must complete and provide the following:

- Scholarship application form
- High School transcripts
- Three letters of recommendation
- Demonstrated leadership and commitment to natural resources or related field.
- Proof of enrollment in an accredited institution of higher education in a natural resource or related field.
- Education and Career Commitment Essay- "What Do You Want to do After College?"
